## **2026 Pool Rules**

### **General:**

- Pool will operate from May 23, 2026 through September 7, 2026
- Hours of operation will consist of the following:

Monday – Friday 10:00 AM – 7:00 PM

Saturday 10:00 AM – 6:00 PM

Sunday 1:00 PM – 6:00 PM

During “Swim Team Season” the pool will close at 6:30 pm for swim practice

- The Pool Department oversees all member activities associated with the pool. The department is headed by the Pool Manager who reports to the General Manager.
- The Management Team sets the pool rules with input from the staff. The rules are subject to change from time to time as may be determined by these entities.
- The pool and associated facilities are for the exclusive use of members, their immediate families, and properly introduced guests.
- The staff is authorized to refuse service to any party not willing to abide by the established safety rules.
- Pool use is at your own risk; Pool staff will be on site but always swim at your own risk.
- Safety is always the primary concern of the Swimming Pool Staff. To ensure everyone’s safety, activities judged unsafe by the lifeguards will not be permitted. Repeated misconduct may result in the individual or group being dismissed from the pool area for the comfort and safety of other members.
- Upon arrival, all patrons (members and guests) must check in at the pool entrance before using the facility. Guests must be registered according to the policy outlined below.
- Management reserves the right to adjust rules, regulations, and/or operating hours at any time to maintain the health and safety of all members and guests.
- All members are responsible for their own actions, as well as the actions of their children and guests.
- Children under 14 years of age must be accompanied by a member or guest at least sixteen years of age.

- Lifeguards and management will determine acceptable pool toys and usage based on pool attendance and activities. Their decision is subject to change at any time to ensure enjoyment and safety for all members and guests.
- No one wearing a bathing suit or other swimwear, without appropriate cover-up, shall be permitted in the Proshop, or on the golf course.
- No one may use the diving boards unless a qualified lifeguard is on duty.
- All people are required to take a cleansing shower before entering the pool.
- Lifeguards are empowered and expected to always maintain a safe aquatic experience.
- One person at a time on the diving board and one spring/bounce per person.
- No alcoholic beverages may be brought in from the outside at any time. Staff reserve the right to check any coolers on club property for outside alcohol.
- The pool will be closed if a chemical imbalance is detected or following a fecal or biohazard contamination or if the water temperature is outside of Wake County limits.
- No smoking or vaping is permitted in the pool area.
- No Profanity at any time in the pool area.

### **Guest Policy:**

- Pool membership includes children living at home under the age of 26
- Guest Fee of \$10.00 per guest, 7 days a week, non-prorated
- Each guest is limited to 5 visits per season
- Grandparents must be accompanied by the member's children and will not be charged guest fees. In the event the parent of the grandchild is present, guest fees will be charged.
- Adult children, age 26 and over are considered guests and must be accompanied by a member and will be charged a guest fee.
- Members are allowed a maximum of FOUR individual guests per day, per household
- Guest Passes are not transferable
- Guests age 2 and under are admitted free
- **Guests will not be permitted on Memorial Day weekend, Labor Day weekend, and July 4<sup>th</sup> weekend along with the holiday itself**
- Any guest child under the age of 14 is required to be with an adult member of the club to enter the pool

## **Babysitter Policy:**

- Babysitters and nannies will be permitted to accompany member children as an extension of the parent membership and will not be charged a guest fee but have no pool privileges without a member child present. The babysitter/nanny must be at least 16 years of age and must be registered with the pool prior to arrival.

## **Pool Dress Code:**

- Clean, proper swim attire must be worn by all individuals using the pool.
- All non-potty-trained children (ages three and under) are required to wear swim diapers (available for purchase at the registration desk)
- Thong bikini and/or Brazilian-cut swim attire, topless and/or nude sunbathing are prohibited
- Cut-offs are prohibited as they can damage pool filtration and pump systems

## **Adult Swim:**

- As signaled by the lifeguards, the last 10 minutes of every hour will be reserved for adult swim/family break
- All people under 18 years of age must exit the pool until the re-entry signal is given by the lifeguards
- There will NOT be a lifeguard on duty during this time, so it is “Swim at Your Own Risk”

## **Inclement Weather:**

- Lifeguards on duty have the final decision regarding weather safety issues  
**Rain** – if rain prevents the lifeguards from clearly seeing the bottom of the pool, all members and guests must exit the water until lifeguards indicate it is safe to return  
**Thunder** – in the event that thunder is heard, all members and guests must exit the water and wait 30 minutes from the last thunder before re-entering the water, as indicated by the lifeguards  
**Lightning** – All members and guests must exit the pool complex, seek safe shelter, and wait 30 minutes after the last lightning sighting before re-entering the pool complex

## **Entering the Pool Facility:**

- All members and guests must check in at the registration desk

- All members are required to show the attendant their club member ID card for entrance
- Club member cards can be picked up at the registration desk
- Replacement cards are subject to a \$5 fee charged at the registration desk
- Members and guests are required to shower before entering the pool
- Blisters, cuts, or open wounds must be seen by a lifeguard before entering the pool

### **Lifeguards:**

- The lifeguards are trained to ensure the safety of all pool members and their guests
- As authority figures, all directives from the lifeguards are to be obeyed
- All members are responsible for their actions, the actions of their children, and their guests
- For safety reasons, do not talk to lifeguards while they are in the lifeguard stand
- Any conduct unbecoming of a Zebulon Country Club member may result in a membership suspension
- Quarrelling, verbally mistreating, or publicly disagreeing with a lifeguard on duty will not be tolerated
- The following disciplinary actions will be taken by the lifeguard staff to ensure the safety of all members and guests
  - 1<sup>st</sup> Warning - Verbal correction
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> Warning - 5-Minute “Time-Out” The individual will be required to sit at the base of the lifeguard stand for a five minute “Time Out”. If appropriate, the individual will bring his/her parent to the lifeguard for an explanation of the rules.
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> Warning - 20-Minute “Time-Out” The individual will be required to sit at the base of the lifeguard stand for 20 minutes. If appropriate, the individual will bring his/her parent to the lifeguard for an explanation of the rules.
  - 4<sup>th</sup> Warning - The individual’s swimming privileges will be suspended for the remainder of the day, and they will be asked to leave the premises.
